
Island Exploded View - Materials & Layers

TECHNICAL DETAILS

The project was conceived as a modular structure that can be easily dismantled, transported and reassembled in new locations, enabling flexibility and adaptability for future installations. This approach ensures that the structure can be relocated efficiently without compromising its architectural integrity or design intent. The project was first presented in Ataşehir, Istanbul, where it was initially installed and exhibited.


FIRST FLOOR PLAN


